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Waiver and Release Form

A. As a condition of being permitted to travel with Love Feeds OUR World (LFOW) on, and participate in, a missions trip to Haiti, during the week noted at the top of this form; the undersigned hereby:

1. Agrees to assume all normal and foreseeable risks associated with travel to, from and within the country of Haiti (including but not limited to natural disasters, terrorism, political unrest, and contraction of illness) and releases LFOW and its affiliates from any responsibility for such risks;
2. Agrees that the LFOW shall have no liability for any personal injury, property damage or other loss, accident, delay, inconvenience, or irregularity which may be caused by (a) any wrongful, negligent or unauthorized acts or omissions on the part of any of the suppliers or their agents, (b) any defect in or failure of any vehicle, equipment or instrument owned, operated or otherwise used by any supplier, or (c) any wrongful or negligent acts or omissions on the part of any other party not under the control of the LFOW;
3. Releases the LFOW, its officers, directors, employees, agents and representatives from any claims whatsoever relating to the missions trip to the Country;
4. Agrees not to sue or otherwise hold the LFOW responsible for any injury, damage, or loss resulting to the undersigned or the undersigned's property in connection with the undersigned's participation in the missions trip to the Country;
5. Accepts full responsibility for luggage and other belongings brought on the missions trip by the undersigned;
6. Agrees to be responsible for any injuries, damages or losses caused by the undersigned while the undersigned is traveling with representatives of the LFOW or while the undersigned is in the Country.

B. The undersigned acknowledges that LFOW has recommended that the undersigned obtain a physical examination and proper inoculations prior to going on the mission trip.

C. The undersigned acknowledges that he/she has been informed that United States citizens traveling outside of the United States are required to carry documentation of United States citizenship, which may include a valid passport or notarized copy of the citizen's birth certificate with a raised seal, and a valid picture I.D. (such as a driver's license).

I certify that the information on this application is true to the best of my knowledge. I grant LFOW permission to conduct a criminal background check. I have read, understand, and agree to the conditions stated on the Waiver and Release form.

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Mission Team Code of Conduct

As a follower of Christ Jesus, our conduct should be a witness to others of a transformed life. Paul wrote in Titus, **“In everything set them an example by doing what is good. In your teaching show integrity, seriousness and soundness of speech that cannot be condemned, so that those who oppose you may be ashamed because they have nothing bad to say about us”** (Titus 2:7-8, NIV).

As a Love Feeds OUR World team member, you are expected to conduct yourself according to the highest standards of integrity and morality. Agreeing to serve on a LFLOW Missions Team means that you are agreeing to adhere to and abide by the guidelines, policies, and procedures of LFLOW. Failure to follow these regulations will result in disciplinary action and possibly your dismissal from the mission field, in which case you will travel home at your own expense or that of your parent or guardian. The following guidelines are meant to further the usefulness and safety of your mission trip. As a LFLOW Missions Team member you are expected to:

1. Treat everyone with respect, loyalty, patience, integrity, courtesy, dignity, sensitivity and consideration.
2. Accept and submit to the leadership role and authority of the team leader(s) and promise to abide by his or her decisions as they concern this mission trip.
3. Refrain from using tobacco, alcohol, or illegal drugs at any time during this mission trip.
4. Refrain from using profanity.
5. Adhere to the dress code and agree to wear modest clothing at all times, this includes at the beach.
6. Refrain from meddling, complaining and using obscene or insensitive humor.
7. Refrain from romantic relationships, flirting or any provocative or inappropriate conversation with team members, leaders, overseas workers or nationals.
8. Complete all tasks willingly and ask for help when needed.
9. Respect the property of others: where we are working (this includes the physical structure we are working on and the tools we work with), where we are staying and of our fellow mission trip participants.
10. Refrain from making promises, giving money or personal gifts to personnel or nationals without permission from the team leader.
11. Make sure the group leader(s) knows where I am at all times. I will not under any circumstances wander off alone while on the mission field or during travel. Women should travel with a man when leaving the campus.
12. Refrain from anything that may distract from my Christian testimony, cause division, or demonstrate disrespect, to missionary personnel, nationals or my fellow team members and leaders.
13. Refrain from giving out my phone number, address, or email or any other personal information. (Please know that you will be asked for your personal information.)
14. Understand that mission trips can be difficult, and promise to adopt a flexible attitude, as plans may need to be changed.
15. Promise to forgo my personal beliefs on these subjects in order to maintain unity and to avoid controversy in the body of Christ.
